Voluntary Respondents to the Contributions
Terms and Conditions / Licence**

The Board of Trustees of the Science Museum and/or SCMG Enterprises Limited (“the Museum”, “us” and/or “we”) are giving you the opportunity to provide your response(s) (“the Work”) to the Either/And contributions. In consideration of this:

1. You hereby grant to the Museum a worldwide, royalty-free **[non-]**exclusive and irrevocable licence in perpetuity to use the Work for any purpose without payment or acknowledgement to you.
2. You consent to all forms of exploitation of the Work (including but not limited to the exhibiting and publishing of the Work) for any purpose in any and all media whether now existing or created in the future.
3. You agree that we shall be entitled to edit, copy, add to and adapt your Work at our discretion.
4. You agree not to assert any right (including moral rights) that would prevent the Museum, or any person authorised by the Museum, from exploiting the Work.
5. You agree to our storing copies of the Work and your contact details on our database in case we need to contact you.
6. You warrant and undertake that:
 - 6.1 you are fully entitled to agree to these Terms and Conditions and grant this licence to us and have obtained all necessary permissions and consents to do so;
 - 6.2 nothing in the Work shall infringe the copyright or any other right of any third party or breach any contract or duty of confidence, constitute a contempt of court or be defamatory, obscene or a breach of confidence or privacy; and
 - 6.3 you acknowledge that we shall not be liable for any loss, damage or injury suffered by you in connection with your Work other than death or personal injury caused by our negligence.
7. You hereby indemnify us irrevocably against all and any costs, claims, expenses and liabilities (including legal fees) in connection with your Work and the breach of any of your obligations under this agreement, including (but not limited to) any claim for infringement of intellectual property rights made by a third party.
8. Our rights under this agreement may be freely assigned or licensed by us.
9. These terms and conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law and will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
